During Pionee'rs overnight, we made yummy Jewish foods. Every group learned the "Shabbat" song and the word of the week was "toda," which means "thank you." Here is a recipe for challah so you can enjoyit at home:

Ingredients

5 egg yolks + 1 to glaze the top 1 1/8 tsp. salt 1 1/2 cups warm water 4 1/2 cups flour (add more as needed)

1/2 cup sugar

1/3 cup oil

1 tablespoon yeast

Combine all ingredients in a large bow and mix until it becomes dough, or place them in a bread maker to mix. Braid dough and glaze with one egg yolk brushed on top. Bake at 350° for approx. 20 -30 minutes.
